SUMMARY OF COMMENTS

Comment: Child Support has the following comment regarding proposed amendments to the child support guidelines.

Section -01(6)(h)(3), deduction for noncommuting mileage. Historically, Child Support has tied the deduction for noncommuting mileage to the amount a state employee is reimbursed when using a personal vehicle for work-related travel (i.e., OMB policy 511). Since this rulemaking project commenced, the mileage rate has increased; as of January 1, 2023, the rate is \$0.655 per mile. Accordingly, we are seeking a conforming change to section -01(6)(h)(3):

(3) Noncommuting mileage incurred for driving a personal vehicle between work locations when required as a condition of employment, computed at the rate of fifty-six sixty-five and one-half cents per mile, less any actual mileage reimbursement from the employer; and

Response: Section 75-02-04.1-01(6)(h)(3) is amended as follows:

(3) Noncommuting mileage incurred for driving a personal vehicle between work locations when required as a condition of employment, computed at the rate of fifty-sixsixty-five and one-half cents per mile, less any actual mileage reimbursement from the employer; and
